About the Keynote Speaker

Sheila Duarte, DDS of Family 1st Dental, Onawa, will discuss how to "Love the Gums You're With - the connection to heart disease." As a dentist, Dr. Duarte screens every patient every day. Because gum disease can play a role in heart disease, patients are screened for any periodontal issues, even sleep apnea, and treated as needed.
