Itinerary

8:00 a.m. – Meet the bus at the **Onawa Community Center** in Onawa: Enjoy sweets, hot coffee or tea, and cold water to start the tour.

8:30 a.m. – Arrive at **Ingemann Danish Church** (built in 1884) in Moorhead: Enjoy the pastoral sights of this little country church and cemetery. Hear the stories of the immigrant's trials and tragedies. This church was featured on the front page of Midwest Magazine.

9:15 a.m. – Depart for **Moorhead Cultural Center** and **Loess Hills Gift Shop** in Moorhead: Local artists and craftsman have their works for sale in the fully restored Cover Country School House. Cross the street to view the "Celebrate the Hills Art Show" at the Moorhead Cultural Center. Public restrooms.

10:15 a.m. – Depart for **Loess Hills Forest Scenic Overlook**: This 40x40, handicap accessible deck provides a panoramic view of the Missouri River Valley for miles and miles. Take a step back in time when the Native Americans stood watch from the tops of the Loess Hills. Learn the history of **Larpenteur Road**, which traces the base of the Loess Hills National Scenic Byway.

11:15 a.m. – Depart for **Loess Hills Lavender Farm**: Bask in the intoxicating aroma and beauty of the lavender. Enjoy a homecooked meal including some lavender recipes. Get creative making a lavender craft. Visit the gift shop filled with lavender plants, bath body products, crafts, and an array of lavender gifts.

2:00 p.m. – Depart for **Trinity Heights**: Marvel at the 22-ft long, life-size, wood sculpture of the Last Supper, and 30-ft, stainless-steel, figures of Mary and Jesus. Stroll the garden pathways to experience the Way of the Saints, honoring more than 60 saints. Visit the **Marian Center Gift Shop**.

4:15 p.m. – Depart for **Browns Family Theater**: Along the way, hear a narrative by your tour guide pointing out historical points, nature reserves and parks, and unique stories from the "Hills."

5:15 p.m. – Arrive at **Browns Family Theater**: Enjoy a delicious buffet dinner (5:30 p.m.) and the antics of three professional actresses who present the show "**Loony Lutherans**" (7:00 p.m.). These wacky girls use music, comedy, and some help from the audience to share some age-old wisdom for living a long healthy life the Lutheran way. (You don't have to be Lutheran to love them.)
